
Directions:

Front Elevation:




Floor Plan:


Established occupancy rate for the New Hill Community Center:


Based on the occupancy rate, the New Hill Community Center offers furniture arrangements at no additional charge to Tenants:

 Typical banquet seating arrangement with space for a DJ, portable bar, and dance floor. This is a very comfortable arrangement with plenty of room between tables. If space for a DJ and dance floor are not needed, another rectangular table can be added along with an additional 3 chairs. Extra chairs are available for placement along the walls or at the head table.

2. Auditorium seating arrangement. Extra chairs are available.




3. In addition to the above, the tables and chairs can be removed should you wish to have an exercise class, dance class, or any activity that does not require tables and chairs.



Caterer's Kitchen
